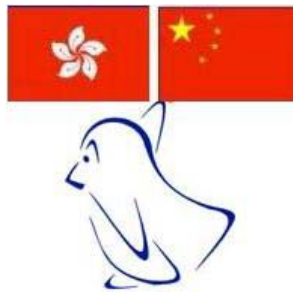

What Support Services available?

Who are eligible to apply?

All ISVs in Hong Kong who have interest in porting their existing software products to OSS platform. Each ISV can submit ONE software application for porting. However, software application solutions that have received financial assistance from other government sources are not eligible



How to assess application?

The project funded by OGCIO aims to provide assistance **for only 20 solutions/companies** in OSS platform porting. A vetting committee with members of ISIA, HKPC, GDLC, related IT associations and academics will be formed for application assessment.

Application procedures

1. Submit the expression of interest form (see next page).
2. HKOSSC will contact the interested applicants individually to understand the solution to be migrated and the project plan for vetting committee's evaluation.
3. Assessment by vetting committee.
